



# WHITE LIGHTNING

## SAFETY RULES

---

- Please put any items from your coolers into our storage location which is under the Mezzanine seating. This will ensure safety to all from the coolers sliding back and forth in the cockpit area.
- Please do not put anything foreign other than the toilet paper supplied into the toilet as this is a self-dissolving toilet paper, anything else must go in the trash cans (paper towels, feminine products etc.)  
**If anything other than the supplied toilet paper goes into the toilet it will stop the auger, and you Will not have a restroom the remainder of the day.**
- Please let the mate know if you feel sick and he will provide you with a bucket to use, also please go outside instead of staying inside the cabin or bathroom if you are going to be sick.  
**If you get sick in the cabin or bathroom you will be held responsible for a \$200.00 cleanup fee.**
- Please do not use the belongings of the owners or captain that are in the refrigerators in the Gally. You may use the microwave, if needed the mate can assist you in running it.
- Guests are not permitted in any of the staterooms or on the bed to the right of the steps.
- If there is an emergency the mate will issue everyone a life jacket as close to the correct size as possible, we also have children's sizes under 90lbs on board.  
Life jackets are located down the steps to the right; there is a placard showing where they are located.  
**If you are handed a life jacket, put your head through the hole, put the strap around your back and snap on the front of the jacket and pull snug.**  
**\*There is an auto activated light and whistle on each life jacket\***
- There is an auto release life raft on board, if needed it will deploy and the captain and mate will assist You in getting to and into the raft.
- There are fire extinguishers located in the Galley, cockpit and every room on the vessel.  
If during your charter you smell or see anything that catches your attention, please make your mate aware of the situation immediately.
- Once we arrive at our destination offshore the mate will put out the rods. Once we get a bite, he will pass the rod to one of the guests, who can choose to use the fighting chair or standup gear (we have both).

- If you have offshore fishing experience, please let the mate know, you will be welcome to help with the rods, etc.
- No guest are allowed on the bridge due to insurance regulations going up and down the ladder in a sea state.
- If a Marlin is hooked, and you are not the guest that is cranking the fish, **you must stay back from the rail until the fish is caught and under control at boat side.** These fish can charge the vessel at fast speeds and possibly jump into the vessel causing serious injury.
- **NO BLACK SOLED SHOES ON THE BOAT AT ANY TIME**
- **ALWAYS BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS WHEN IN THE COCKPIT.**
- Please initial the provided waiver and return it before your charter
